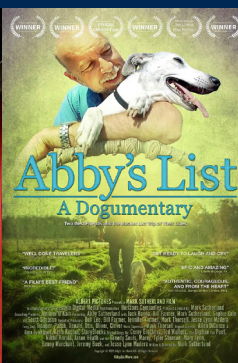
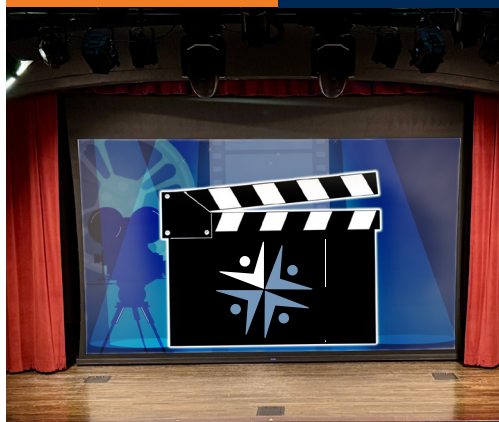

Hang On Sloopy the Movie– Featuring Live Band Performance

Friday, August 28, 2026 | 7 pm

Hang On Sloopy: The Movie is a “ROCKumentary” about a university and an entire state’s incredible 50-year love affair with a rock song. Our screening features a panel discussion as well as a live performance by members of the Rick Derringer Band: Kenn Moutenot, Charles Torres, and Danny Johnson.

Produced in Columbus, Ohio by Dave Whinham and Brian Grady, the piece explores many untold and magical stories about how a random rock song, about a “girl from a very bad part of town” became to the State of Ohio what “Sweet Home Alabama” is to the State of Alabama.

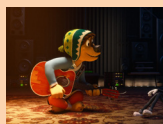
